Dear Members,

Welcome to the Washington Daffodil Society bulb order. We, at the WDS, are appreciative of the support of our members both locally and across the country. In the past year we have had to take a long hard look at the sustainability of the bulb order. We hope you will understand that some money and time-saving changes have been made in order to continue this service.

Please note that shipping costs have increased to meet with current rates. Prices on imports include air mail and inspection fees. If you plan to attend the WDS, MDS or Tuscarora fall meetings, please DO NOT ADD POSTAGE. We will make arrangements for your bulbs to be available for you at these meetings. If you place your order through one of our valued garden club memberships, all bulbs must be sent to one address (Exception: If you are an individual member as well, this does not apply.(SEE ORDER FORM FOR SHIPPING RATES) Most importantly, a May 31st deadline must be adhered to. Any later and we risk that our suppliers will have sold out of some of the choice bulbs. Another change is that gratis bulbs will only be awarded at the October 28th bulb exchange. ALL are welcome to attend; Don't miss the live auctions and bulb picks!

We have streamlined the list of offerings. This year every bulb on our list is of show quality and many will thrive in your garden landscapes as well. *WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO VIEW EACH BULB YOU ORDER ON DAFFSEEK (EXCEPT THE UNREGISTERED SEEDLINGS)* Just click on the name of the bulb and it will hyper-link you to the Daffseek page.

We have reduced the number of "bulbs of the year" because there are too many that will meet the criteria!! Most have been gold (best of show) or white (best 3 of a kind) ribbon or been in winning collections in the last few years!! Please note the expanded listing of miniatures & intermediates, due to popular demand.

Explanation of classification and color coding: the number is one of 13 Royal Horticulture Society divisions -- 1 is trumpet, 2 is large cup, etc. The letters indicate color; perianth color follows the division number, and the cup color beginning at the eye is shown after the hyphen. (Y = yellow, G = green, O = orange, P = pink, R = red.) The name of the originator and date of registration follow. Blooming time is signified as E = early, M = mid-season, and L = late.

ALL BULBS ARE OFFERED SUBJECT TO CROP. Prices are for one bulb. We reserve the right to make substitutions for bulbs in the collections, but we do try to avoid that if at all possible. Any complaint as to the quality of bulbs should be made in writing to either Scott or Karen by Dec 31, 2017
